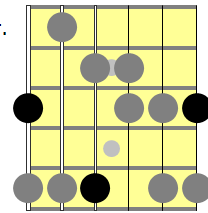

Fingerings (T, A, B):

- Measure 3: T (7, 10, 7, 8, 10, 7, 8, 8)
- Measure 4: T (7, 8, 8, 10, 8, 8, 10, 8)

Third system of the Kumoi Scale Pattern #2, measures 5-6.

Notes: G6 (18th fret), A6 (19th fret), B6 (20th fret), C7 (21st fret), D7 (22nd fret), E7 (23rd fret), F7 (24th fret), G7 (25th fret), A7 (26th fret), B7 (27th fret), C8 (28th fret), D8 (29th fret), E8 (30th fret), F8 (31st fret), G8 (32nd fret), A8 (33rd fret), B8 (34th fret), C9 (35th fret).

Fingerings (T, A, B):

- Measure 5: T (8, 10, 8, 10, 10, 8, 10, 8)
- Measure 6: T (8, 10, 8, 8, 10, 8, 8, 7)

Fourth system of the Kumoi Scale Pattern #2, measures 7-8.

Notes: D8 (29th fret), E8 (30th fret), F8 (31st fret), G8 (32nd fret), A8 (33rd fret), B8 (34th fret), C9 (35th fret), D9 (36th fret), E9 (37th fret), F9 (38th fret), G9 (39th fret), A9 (40th fret), B9 (41st fret), C10 (42nd fret), D10 (43rd fret), E10 (44th fret), F10 (45th fret).

Fingerings (T, A, B):

- Measure 7: T (8, 8, 7, 10, 8, 7, 10, 7)
- Measure 8: T (7, 10, 7, 10, 7, 10, 6, 7, 10, 6, 10, 6, 10, 8)

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
